**COLLEGE PLANS CENTENNIAL**

A plaque commemorating the founding of Albright College 100 years ago will be presented to the community of New Berlin, Pa., in special services Oct. 16.

This is the second event in celebration of Albright College's centennial observance.

Approximately 150 ft. from the present Western Area Joint Elementary School, Albright was founded as Union Sem-

ary. The building then erected housed the college until it was moved to Myerstown, Pa., in 1902. Albright has been on its present campus in Reading since 1929.

Rev. E. C. Basom, retired minister of the Evangelical United Brethren Church, and former student at the New Berlin college, will give the main address. Albright President Harry V. Masters will greet those assembled. New Berlin is the site of the first church building and the first publishing house of the Evangelical, now EUB, Church. Copies of the college history prepared for the centennial celebration, will be presented to the local schools and historical society. Albright is one of the seven colleges throughout the country sponsored by the EUB Church. The Alumni Homecoming and official convocation is scheduled for October 22.

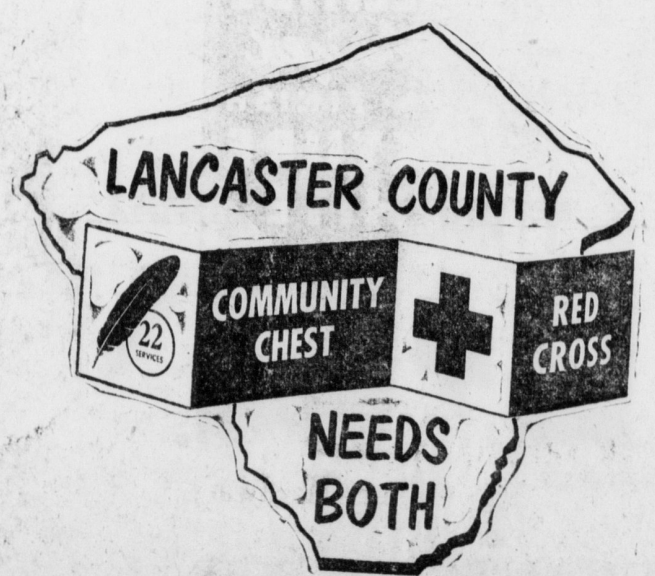
