Notice is hereby given by the Directors of the School District of the Township of East Donegal, Lancaster County, Pa., to all electors of such District that, by authority of a resolution unanimously adopted on August 12, 1955, at the general municipal election to be held November 8th, 1955, at the regular polling places within the Township between 7:00 A. M. and 8 P. M., the following question will appear on the ballot for the purpose of obtaining the consent of the electors to the action proposed:

Shall the Board of School Directors of East Donegal Township be permitted to increase the indebtedness of said school district an additional amount not to exceed \$80,000.00 for the purpose of remodeling of and additions to the Maytown Elementary School.

The last assessed valuation of the municipality is \$7,322,165.00, of which \$3,661,165 is taxable. The sum of the existing gross liabilities is \$34,000.00.

The sum of the allowable deductions which are claimed are \$23,647.50.

The amount of the net debt of the municipality is \$10,352,500.

The amount of the proposed increase of debt is \$80,000.00. The above figures were computed September 14, 1955, and no appreciable change has occurred since then.

The purpose for which the debt is to be increased is the remodeling of and additions to the Maytown Elementary School.
