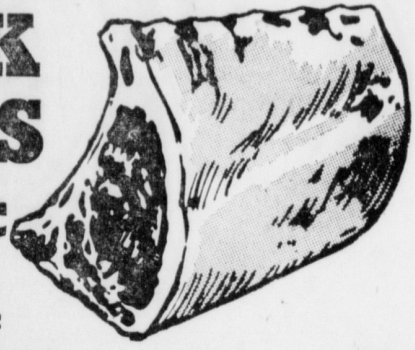

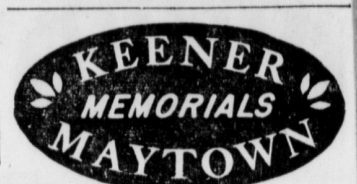
## SALLY NISSLEY RECEIVES HONORS

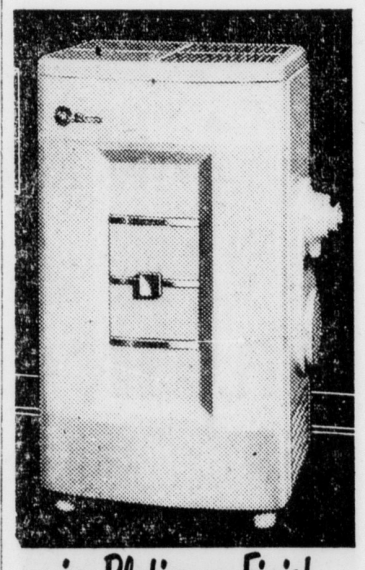
## Rotary Club Has Auction Day
