SUBMARINE TRAINING FOR HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATES

It was announced today by Chief James Stevens, in charge of the Lancaster Navy Recruiting Office, that the Navy has now opened its Submarine training to High School Graduates in conjunction with the High School Graduate Training Program.

The Chief explained it this way: If you are a High School Graduate, and desire Submarine Training and duty you will be enlisted under the High School Graduate Training Program. You will not be guaranteed Sub training upon enlistment, but if you meet all the requirements for Submarines which means special Physical examination, Psychological fitness and the desire to be a "Submarine Sailor" you are as he put it "in".

This program has been necessitated by the fact that many men desiring Submarine training are not taking advantage of the opportunities due to the fact that even if they qualify there has been no guarantee of this type training in the past. Submarine men, the Chief said, get the hazardous duty pay that Aviators and Frogmen get. Hazardous duty pay starts at \$55.00 to \$245.00 per month.
