DRIVERS URGED TO PREPARE FOR WINTER

Harrisburg -PNS- Winter is coming - and so are sometimes woeful winter driving troubles. Penna. safety officials warned this week.

"Prepare now for winter's onslaught - don't wait until it's too late," was the plea of the Bureau of Highway Safety. "If we are adequately prepared in the early phases of the annual battle with this ancient foe, we stand a better chance of completing the entire cold season without casualties."

It was noted also - as State Police already have - that most car owners seem to feel that getting their vehicle ready for winter consists simply of driving to their favorite service station to have the radiator filled with antifreeze and changing oil and grease to a lighter grade.

"That's a good start but to put up a successful fight against the sneak attack of Jack Frost, the Snowman and all the other winter enemies of the motorist, it is highly essential that windshield wipers and defrosters in particular be functioning perfectly," the bureau spokesman warned.

It was pointed out that reports of the National Safety Council show that in one out of five fatal accidents, the driver's vision was obscured - with obscurement too often being freezing rain or snow.

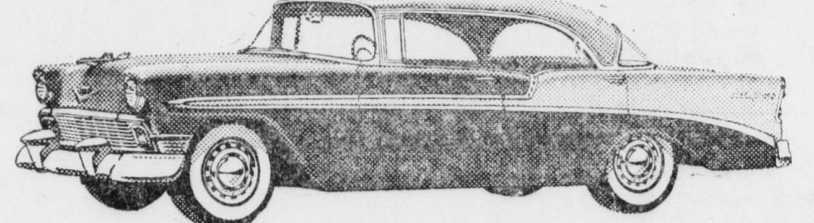
