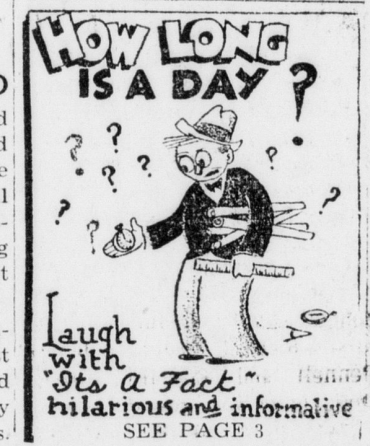
FALLS FROM LADDER
