New Holiday Candies

Here are recipes for wonderful no-cook candies that are so easy to make and so good to eat. They are inexpensive too so make a generous supply of these chocolate and fruit candies for your Christmas parties and gift boxes.

No-Cook Chocolate Chews
 2 tablespoons butter or margarine
 1/2 cup Karo Syrup, Blue or Red Label
 2 squares unsweetened chocolate, melted
 1 teaspoon vanilla
 3 cups sifted confectioners' sugar
 3/4 cup nonfat dry milk solids
 Blend butter and corn syrup; stir in chocolate and vanilla. Combine confectioners' sugar and milk solids. Add to corn syrup mixture gradually; stir, then knead until thoroughly blended. Form into rolls and cut into inch pieces with knife or scissors, or roll into balls. Makes 1 1/2 pounds.

No-Cook Apricot Coconut Balls
 2 tablespoons butter or margarine
 1/2 cup light corn syrup
 1 tablespoon water
 1/2 teaspoon vanilla
 1/4 teaspoon almond extract, optional
 3/4 cup nonfat dry milk solids
 2 cups dried apricots, finely chopped or ground
 2 cups shredded coconut, finely cut
 Blend butter and corn syrup; stir in water, flavorings and milk solids. Mix apricots and coconut together; add to corn syrup mixture and knead until thoroughly blended. Form into balls. Dip in confectioners' sugar, if desired. Makes about 1 1/2 pounds.
