Plans Completed For Saturday Church Bazaar

The Mount Joy Presbyterian Church will stage its first bazaar this Saturday, Dec. 3, in the church basement. Held in conjunction with the bazaar will be a supper. Hours for the bazaar will be from 12 noon until 9 p.m. and the hours for the supper will be from 5 to 9 p.m. Tickets for the supper may be obtained at the door. The supper which includes baked beans, barbecued hamburger on roll, greens and applesauce, will cost 75c for adults and 50c for children. Pie, cake and ice cream will also be sold.

The bazaar will include a handwork table; Christmas decorations and wrappings table; Homemade items which will be pies, cakes and candy; pantry shelf which will be homemade relishes, pickles, chili, and other homemade items; a treasures and trinkets table; and a fish pond for the children.

Christmas wrappings will include Elinor Finch handprints, flint paper and folded wrappings. Other Christmas items will include felt items, corsages, knit stockings for hanging, Christmas Eve, and Christmas earrings.

Handwork items will include kitchen and Christmas aprons, stuffed toys, hand puppets, hot pads, knit booties and baby socks, dressed dolls, needle point picture, crayon aprons, pillow cases, note paper with a picture of Donegal Church imprinted on it, and pecan nut meats.

The public is invited to attend this first annual bazaar of the church. Entrance to both the bazaar and supper may be gained by using the side door to the church.
