## VACCINATION HAS IMPORTANT ROLE IN DISEASE CONTROL

Harrisburg -PNS- Additional evidence that calfhood vaccination is playing a big part in the control and elimination of brucellosis or Bang's disease of cattle in Pennsylvania was shown this week by results of recent tests of agents of the State Department of Agriculture.

In the completion of an area brucellosis blood testing of 93 herds comprising 1438 cattle in one county, it was shown that the incidence of infection was down to 6.8 per cent.

Three years ago when similar tests were made in the same area and same herds, the incidence of infection was 16 per cent.

In addition to intensive calfhood vaccination, the department told Penna. News Service that it attributes advancements in brucellosis control throughout the state to the effective educational program of the agricultural extension service of Pennsylvania State University, the advice of local veterinarians, isolation of infected animals, rigid attention to matters of sanitation and in the selection of animals to be added to a herd.

"The program for the elimination of bang's disease in all throughout Pennsylvania is steadily moving ahead - a move which ultimately will see Pennsylvania with bang's free cattle," the department noted.

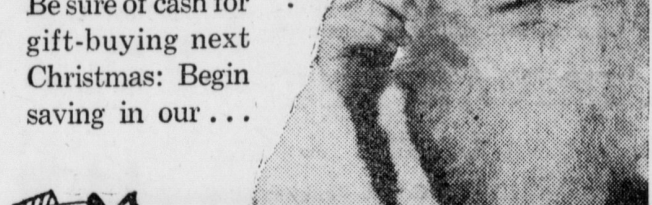
