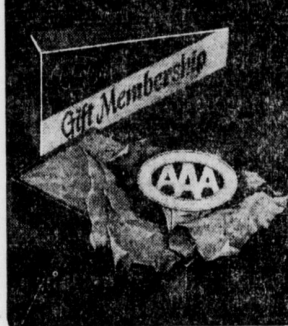

**HARRISBURG  
ROUND-UP**

Harrisburg — "Exploration" is once again the byword in legislative circles, as lawmakers gather this week for brief sessions following last week's shelving by Senate Republicans of the Governor's manufacturers excise tax.

It is a question now of exploring new tax avenues upon which Republican and Democratic lawmakers might agree — a task which in twelve months has been productive of a classified income tax and a manufacturers excise tax, both of which were murderously defeated in the GOP-controlled Senate.

Republicans expect absolutely nothing to be gained from the Governor's talks this week with so-called leaders of industry in Pennsylvania in an avowed effort to find out what taxes industry would go along with.

Generally GOP leaders view the conference as just so much political window-dressing.

The tax defeat of last week undoubtedly was the climax of the 1955 session of the Legislature as it prepares to spill over into 1956 and thus become the longest session in the record of the Commonwealth.

During those days last week when the tax issue reached the critical stage personal vituperation reached an all-time high for the year as physical frays threatened to break out on the floor of the once august and dignified Senate chamber.

The Legislature after this week is expected to recess until the week of January 16 to make way for the Christmas holidays and the Farm Show the week of January 9.

Interestingly perhaps, Democratic House Majority leader Albert S. Readinger has once again suggested that a tax program be worked out along a compromise sales-income tax line — the income tax embracing the levy Republicans are oppos-

ed to and the sales tax embracing the levy Democrats oppose.

On other legislative fronts, the Legislature now has before it for House consideration an stop-gap appropriation bill of some \$110 million to provide state aid for distressed school districts throughout the state overdue on state aid payments.

And in the Senate two administration proposals for re-organization of some state government functions were slammed down to defeat in the GOP Senate. These would have transferred some 16 licensing boards from the Department of Public Instruction to the Secretary of the Commonwealth.

In other activity a few new bills limped into the legislative hopper, including those which would:

Increase the permissible tax rate for boroughs;

Authorize the State Historical Commission to appoint a county historian in each county;

Authorize expanded audiovisual education programs in public schools of the state;

Require the closing of schools on election days.

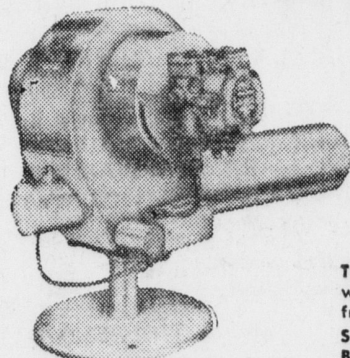
