Philadelphia detectives deternined that HEIMOVITZ, better known as MAX HERMAN, has peen the man behind the gun and behind the gun and immediately a fragnet was put out in a vain effort to apprehend the murderer.

HEMOVITZ was well-known as a numbers writer and parttime jewelry salesman, but the ii reason for the shooting was obscure. Some claimed that it was because of a personal grudge that MAX had against the two; others claimed that it was an offshoot of a local numrs writers' quarrel. The fugi ive has a long criminal record dating back to 1932, and includes blackmain, extortion, carrying concealed deadly weapons, and operating an illegal


