the foul line and from the field.
Manheim outscored Donegal,
19-12, in the first period, and
at one time enjoyed an 11 to 2
lead. In the second period Don-
egal began to find the range,
and out-scored the Barons 14 to
9, but Manheim still maintain-
ed a one point lead at half
time.
In the third period, the lead
see-sawed back and forth sev-
eral times, with Donegal com-
ing out on top at the end of
the period 39-37. The Indians
continued to hold the two point
lead throughout the first half of
the final period, at this point
Manheim scored on a question-
able goal, after this happened
both teams matched point for
point causing the overtime peri-
od.

scorer for the winners, and
Rowell, with 12 points, was
high man for Donegal.
