**APPROVING THE PLAN SUBMITTED BY MT. JOY BOROUGH AUTHORITY FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A SANITARY SEWAGE SYSTEM FOR THE BOROUGH OF MT. JOY, LANCASTER COUNTY, AND OTHER AREAS; PROPOSING TO CHARGE AND ASSESS A PART OF THE COST OF CONSTRUCTION OF SEWERS IN THE BOROUGH OF MT. JOY INCLUDED WITHIN THE SANITARY SEWAGE SYSTEM AGAINST THE PROPERTIES BENEFITED, IMPROVED OR ACCOMMODATED, ACCORDING TO THE FOOT FRONT RULE**

WHEREAS, Mt. Joy Borough Authority has submitted to the Council of the Borough of Mt. Joy certified copy of its resolution adopted April 5, 1956, concerning, in part, the construction of sanitary sewers for the Borough of Mt. Joy; and

WHEREAS, in connection with such construction, and as set forth in said resolution, Authority proposes to assess a part of the cost of such sewers against properties benefited, improved or accommodated thereby according to the foot front rule; and

WHEREAS, such plan and estimated cost are submitted by the Authority for approval of the Council of the Borough of Mt. Joy, pursuant to the provisions of Paragraph (a) Subdivision B of Section 4 of the Municipality Authorities Act of May 2, 1945, P. L. 382, as amended;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the Borough of Mt. Joy, Lancaster County, Pa., hereby ordains and enacts that: Section 1. The Council of the Borough of Mt. Joy hereby approves the report and plan dated March 16th, 1956, of Joseph A. Michels, Consulting Engineer, Dallsstown, Pennsylvania, as submitted to this meeting, for the construction of sanitary sewers for the Borough of Mt. Joy.

Section 2. The estimated cost of sewers as set forth in said report and plan in the total amount of \$1,370,000.00 and the proposal of Mt. Joy Borough Authority to assess \$347,643.00 of the total cost of such sewers against the property benefited, improved or accommodated thereby, according to the foot front rule are hereby approved for the purpose and with the effect set forth.

Section 3. All ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith, be and the same are hereby repealed. DULY ENACTED by the Council of the Borough of Mt. Joy, Lancaster County of the Borough of Mt. Joy, Lancaster County, Pa., this 5th day of April, 1956.

**RESOLUTION TO ACQUIRE ABSOLUTE TITLE TO MT. JOY BOROUGH SCHOOL PROPERTY** BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of School Directors of the School District of the Borough of Mount Joy, Lancaster County, Pa., that this School District hereby declares its intention, pursuant to the Act of July 2, 1937, P. L. 2793, to acquire a fee simple absolute title to the easterly portion of its "Mt. Joy Elementary School" premises bounded by S. Market Marietta and Delta streets, in Lancaster County, Pa., which portion is described as follows:

**SALE OF SCHOOL BONDS** The School District of East Donegal Township, Lancaster County, Pennsylvania, will receive bids for the purchase of 80 general obligation bonds of the Township of East Donegal of the denomination of One Thousand (\$1,000.00) Dollars each, aggregating Eighty Thousand (\$80,000.00) Dollars, dated June 1, 1956, to be issued by said School District in order to provide funds for the remodeling of and additions to the Maytown Elementary School within the said School District.
