Homemakers Group Has Meeting
The Mount Joy Homemakers Group had two representatives at the planning meeting held recently in the Farm Bureau Building. A group of county representatives along with Miss Ruth Kimble, Co. Home Ec. Extension Director reviewed this past year meeting and the projects completed. The local group received instructions in Casserole meals, Tailor mending, wood refinishing, growing old gracefully, Broiler meals, Clothing construction. Use of wearing of accessories and covering lamp shades. The years finished products were displayed at the County Homemakers Day program that was held in the First Presbyterian Church, Lancaster, April 25th.
New extension meetings beginning in the fall and continuing until spring will include Clothing construction, Tailoring for advanced members and slipcovering, Entertaining, Using the freezer to better advantage, Laundry supplies - (soaps, syndets, bleaches and water softeners), Use of color in home (slipcovers & drapes) and Family Fun.
The instruction is offered as a public service through the State Agriculture and Home Ec. Extension Program and is available to any one interested. Mrs. Daniel S. Will, Mt. Joy R2, is president of the local group and anyone desiring information concerning next fall's classes can contact her or the County Extension Office Director, Miss Ruth Kimble in the Post Office Building, Lancaster.

SALE OF SCHOOL BONDS
The School District of East Donegal Township, Lancaster County, Pennsylvania, will receive bids for the purchase of 80 general obligation bonds of the School District of One Thousand (\$1,000.00) Dollars each, aggregating Eighty Thousand (\$80,000.00) Dollars, dated July 1, 1956, to be issued by said School District in order to provide funds for the remodeling of and additions to the Maytown Elementary School within the said School District.
The bonds will mature serially on the anniversary date of the bonds at the rate of six (6) bonds in 1959, six (6) bonds in 1961 and six (5) bonds annually from 1963 to 1972 inclusive, and six (6) bonds annually, 1973 to 1975 inclusive, with the option in the said School District to redeem on any interest paying date beginning with June 1, 1963, in the inverse order of their maturity, any and all outstanding bonds maturing in or after 1963 with the payment of the following premium: from 1963 to 1966 inclusive at three (3%) per cent; 1967 to 1970 inclusive two (2%) per cent; 1971 to 1973 inclusive at one (1%) per cent; and on after June 1, 1973, at par.
Interest will be paid semi-annually on January 1st and July 1st at a rate to be named by the bidder in multiples of one-eighth (1/8) of one (1%) per cent. No bids will be accepted which are for less than the entire issue, which contains different interest rates, or which are for less than the par and accrued interest.
The holder shall have option of registering principal only.
Principal and interest will be payable without deduction for any tax or taxes, except succession or inheritance taxes, now or hereafter levied or assessed thereon under any present or future law of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, all of which taxes the School District assumes and agrees to pay.
