Show Increase**

Earnings accruing to the
common stock of Pennsylv-
ania Power & Light Company
for the twelve months ended
April 30, 1956 were \$19,119-
889, equivalent to \$3.23 per
share of common stock out-
standing at such date, as
compared with \$18,047,584
or \$3.06 per share for the
twelve months ended April
30, 1955. Earnings for both
periods include earnings of
former subsidiary, The
Scranton Electric Company,
(merged January 31, 1956)
and restated earnings of the
former Pennsylvania Water
& Power Company (merged
June 1, 1955) for applicable
periods prior to merger.
Revenues for the twelve
months ended April 30, 1956

on the same basis were \$125-
645,085, an increase of 7.8
per cent over comparable
revenues for the previous
year.
