

P. P. & L. Offices Closed Saturdays

Pennsylvania Power and Light Company commercial offices will no longer be open Saturdays, beginning June 16, Mr. G. T. Storb, the utility's Lancaster division vice president, announced today. Regular hours for the commercial offices will now be 8 a. m. to 5 p. m., Monday through Friday, except for special holidays.

The change in office hours will in no way inconvenience customers in making telephone reports concerning service. Present arrangements for handling "after hours" telephone calls have been extended to include Saturday morning.

Mr. Storb explained the primary reason for the change in office hours is to standardize work schedules of employees of the commercial offices with those of employees in the other business offices of the company. The move also recognizes that customers use of PP&L commercial offices on Saturday mornings has dwindled in recent years.

It is anticipated that the Saturday morning closings will not inconvenience customers in paying service bills. Bills may be paid at company offices at anytime after new hours, through the bill payment depository facilities now installed at all P. P. & L. commercial offices. Envelopes are available in containers located near each depository for enclosing customers' payments.

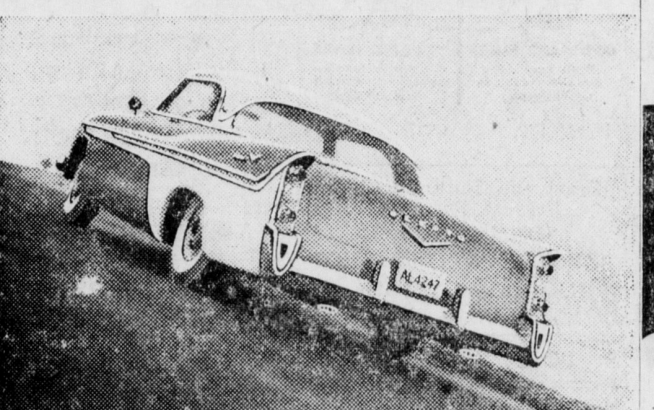

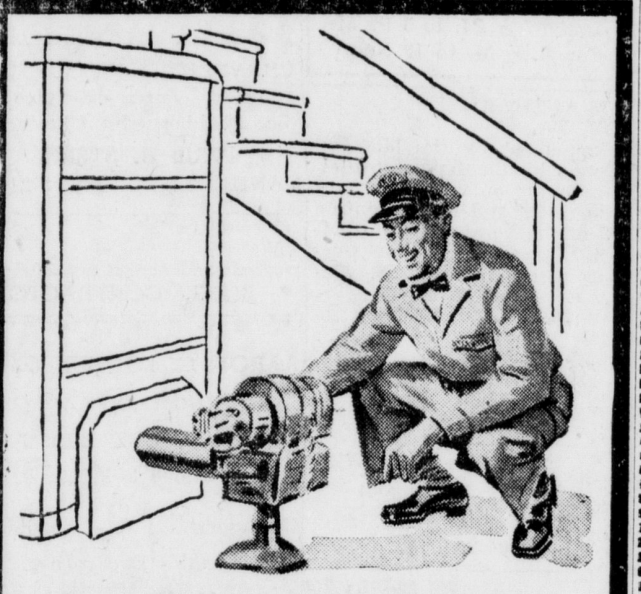
