Building Activity Shows Increase

Harrisburg -PNS- Construction activity throughout Pennsylvania during the past month swung upwards sharply as seasonal home building operations slipped into high gear.

On the home front a total of 3467 new residential projects got under way—which was 19.6 per cent more than that of the preceding month.

The value of these new residential units, at \$41 1/2 million was up 22 per cent over the previous month.

The dwelling units started last month are scheduled to provide homes for 3572 families—which again is an upswing of 12 per cent over the preceding month.

In the field of new non-residential building, 964 new projects were scheduled throughout the state during the month—which compares with 645 during the preceding month.

Costwise, these projects are estimated at better than \$25 1/2 million, which is a whopping 60 per cent over and above that of the previous month.

Interestingly, expenditures for new schools, stores and mercantile buildings accounted for a large percentage of the increase in this category.

A glance at the overall picture shows that total estimated cost of current projects is around \$80 million as compared with \$61 million in the month before.
