

# Donegal Airport News

Joanne Landis very successfully accomplished her first 'solo' flight on Monday evening and now has more than two and one half hours of flight experience. Next on her program will be a cross country trip with some pointers on the use of air maps, the compass course, and the study of terrain features and recognition of check points shown on the maps. These are the elementary requirements in making the airplane useful as a transportation vehicle. Cross country travel is always interesting with many new things to be learned by the student pilot.

Wally Sheaffer of Elizabethtown is a mechanic who fixes airplanes and can't fly them, but as part time mechanic at Donegal airport, Wally is taking time between jobs, to learn to fly them too, with Leon Allemen as his instructor.

Jim Murray, Elizabethtown, and Gene Johnson, Marietta, are co-owners of a Luscombe Silvaire. They repainted it and have had mechanic Wally Sheaffer do a top overhaul on its 65 h.p. Continental engine, putting this good looking plane in top notch condition. Jim and Gene are student pilots who are using their own plane to gain experience needed for a pilot license.

One of our interesting flight activities the past winter and spring has been the chick deliveries from a nearby hatchery to Virginia, North Carolina and New York state. Our most recent trip was last Thursday when we flew a shipment of 1800 high quality foundation chicks to Clinton, N. C., in 2 hours and 45 minutes. We have found that by careful control of heat and ventilation we can provide comfort in winter for 'peeps'; while in hot summer when there is a danger of overheating we can keep them comfortable by flying at a higher, cooler altitude.

There is much need for more air education, for although the airplane has been with us for 50 years the general public knows surprisingly little about its use, especially in private use and in executive, or business air transportation. Broadly speaking there are two types of air traffic rules, one for flights under 'instrument' conditions, and the other for flights in clear weather with 'ceilings' and 'visibility' above certain prescribed minimums. The first is known as operating on Instrument Flight Rules or IFR, while the second is Visual Flight Rules or VFR. The average 'fair weather pilot' always travels VFR, he can go higher and yon, as and when he pleases, and so long as he

stays out of controlled high density traffic areas he does not even need a radio. If he plans to make a long flight, he may, if he so desires, file a 'flight plan' with the nearest Civil Aeronautics Communication Station by telephone or in person, giving his name and other information pertinent to the flight, including of course, the time and place of his intended landing. This information is then transmitted by teletype to the communications station at or nearest to his destination airport, which he must notify upon arrival, thus 'closing' his flight plan. This valuable supervisory service costs the pilot nothing but a little of his time.

Harold Krall has logged quite a bit of solo time and is practicing up on takeoff and landing, getting real good on both 'wheel' and 'three point' landings. Russell Swarr is back again learning to fly the Cessna 120. John Hawthorne is teaching some of our local pilots to make 'instrument approaches' at Lancaster Municipal, using the Omni Range and the low frequency beacon. Results are amazing to pilots who beforehand knew nothing about the procedure.

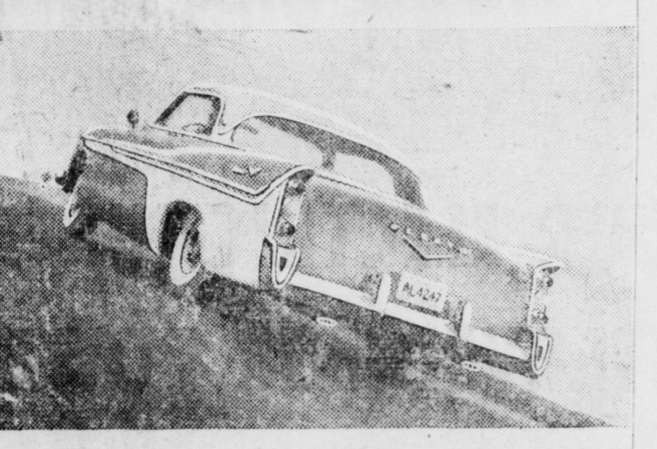

## Farm Calendar

Timely Reminders from The Penn. State University College of Agriculture

PLAN WINTER FEED — Roughage is the backbone of our beef cattle industry, according to Thomas King, Penn State extension livestock specialist. While our pastures are producing now, we also have to plan for plenty of roughage next winter. Hay still ranks at the top, but silage is becoming popular with many cattlemen.

ENROLL IN FARM CLUBS — The Pennsylvania Corn Club and the Pennsylvania Grassland Club are open to Pennsylvania farmers 21 yrs. old and older. They are sponsored by the Pennsylvania Crop Improvement Association, in cooperation with the Agricultural Extension Service of the Pennsylvania State University.

CHECK HAY DRIER — Be sure your hay drier is in good order, reminds Morris Schroeder, Penn State Extension agricultural engineer.
