### Reich's Church Sunday School Formed In 1900

(Continued from last week)

On Saturday evening, April 7, 1900, a special meeting was called after the preaching service to discuss the subject of a Sunday School. An organization was then effected with Harry Ney elected superintendent; Emma Smith, assistant supt.; Catherine Herr, Secretary; Cyrus Smith treasurer; and William Fackler, librarian. It was decided to hold the Sunday School sessions in the morning, "beginning at nine o'clock sharp to continue for one hour," with the first meeting to be held the following Sunday, April 15, 1900. At the same meeting the pastor, the Rev. L. C. Wiest, informed the members that the idea of buying the church would have to be dropped for the present on account of circumstances that they could not control. An announcement was made also that a collection would be taken up on the Sunday evening to help defray the moving expenses of the minister.

On May 9, 1900, the trustees of the church were informed that the church could be bought for \$1,100 and that Mr. Reich would give \$100 toward it, making the cost \$1,000. A vote was taken, and it was decided to buy the church. Mr. Reich asked twenty-five dollars "to bind the bargain," which sum would be forfeited as rent should they decide at the end of the year not to purchase the church. At a later date during the year it was learned that a satisfactory title for the property could not be secured, the contract with Mr. Reich would expire, the twenty-five dollars would be forfeited for rent, and there would be no place to worship. It was then decided to rent the building on the previous terms of twenty dollars per annum. This standing agreement between Mr. Reich and the Reich's of Bethel Class continued thru 1901 and 1902. On May 2, 1902, the Reich's Class became a part of the Columbia Mission.

An agreement of sale was made in 1904 between H. L. Reich and S. F. Frey, and later an agreement between S. F. Frey and H. L. Reich. The trustees of the United Evangelical Church purchased the church property from Harmon Reich on October 5, 1905. In October, 1906, the trustees voted "to build shedding for six or eight horses and wagons as they see fit, and they authorized C. Frank to purchase the lumber. Some time later the shedding was constructed at an expense of \$70.50. Later the Conference detached East Petersburg from Manheim and added it to Kinderhook and Reich's, and in 1910 the Rev. W. A. Shoemaker was appointed to serve the circuit. From the minutes of March 30, 1910, we find that the preacher's salary was fixed at \$125 per year, but a note is added that more will be paid "if collections warrant it." Of April 15, 1916, the pastor was to be paid \$85 per year and if more was collected over that amount, it was to go toward the church.
