Two Cows Are Tested By HFR  
A special report of the Holstein-Friesian Association of America, Brattleboro, Vt., announces the completion of official production records by two registered Holstein cows in the herd of Henry Hess of Mount Joy, and M. W. Wenger, Rheems.

Hess' Clovena Lucifer Rose, 3060576, was milked twice daily for 365 days and produced a total of 18,860 pounds of milk and 702 lbs. of butterfat. She was 6 years old at the time of testing.

Wenger's Wmbro Nora Dunloggin Lochinvar 2603547, was milked twice daily for 314 days and produced a total of 15,712 pounds of milk and 538 pounds of butterfat. She was 9 years old at the time of testing.

The Pennsylvania State University supervised the weighing and testing of these records which compare with an annual production of only 5,815 pounds of milk and 224 pounds of butterfat by the average U. S. cow. The new records are a part of the national Holstein organization's Herd Improvement Registry—an official testing program designed to provide individual lactation and lifetime production records on every cow in participating herds.

Registered Holstein breeders in all 48 states are utilizing HFR records as tools in the wise selection of individuals, families and bloodlines so vital to the continued improvement of their herds.
