Miss Blough stated that it is extremely important to Civil Defense in Lancaster County to have this registry in case of any disaster occurring in Lancaster County.

All Nurses are asked and urged to contact the P.T.A. in their area to fill out an information card, or call Miss Blough at Lancaster, 3-3958.

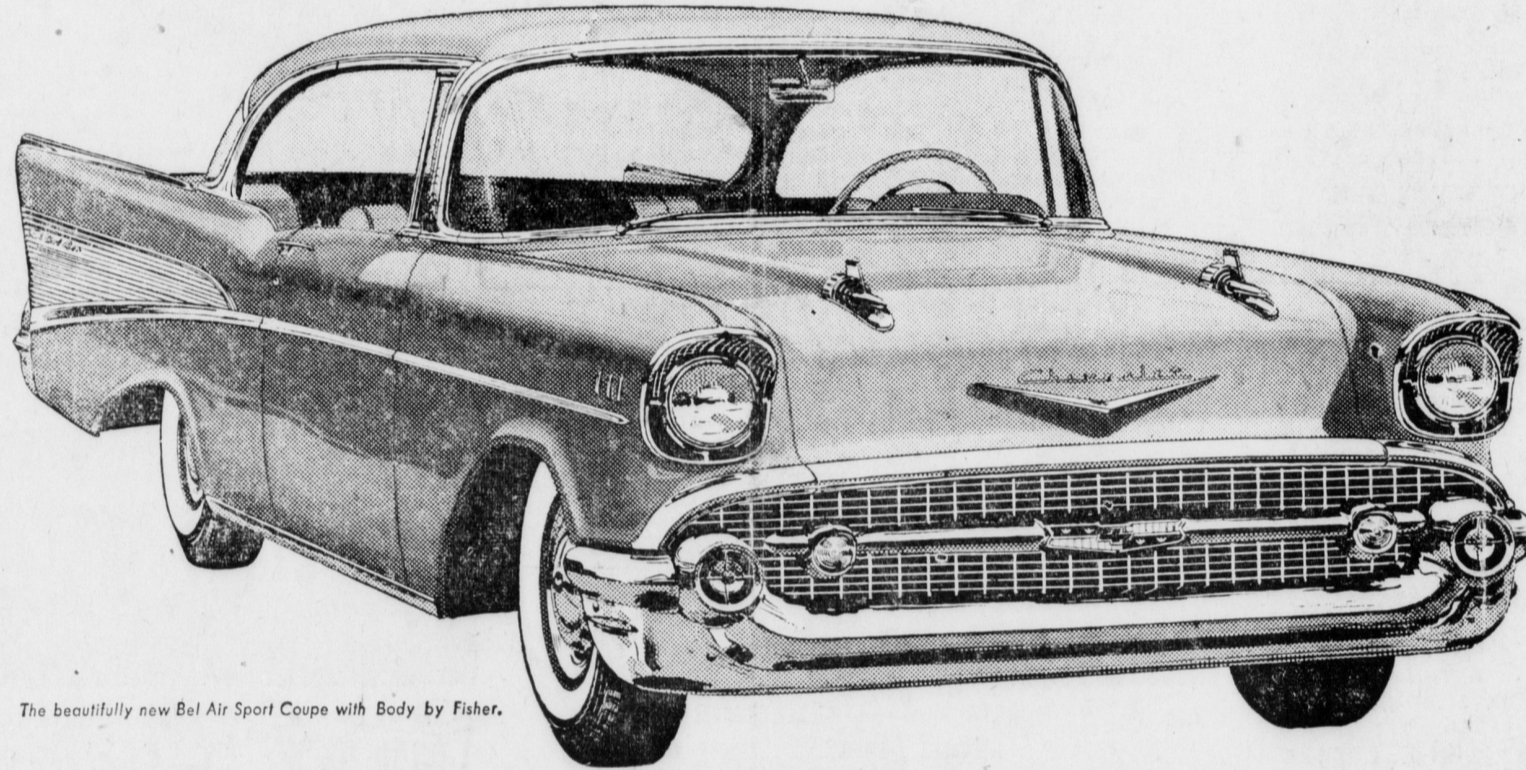

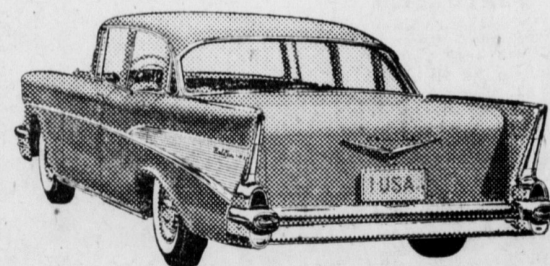
