

**ELECTS OFFICERS**

**New Dates Set For Examinations For State Jobs**

The State Civil Service Commission has announced a new examination date and the extension of the recruitment period for employment counselors and interviewers, and for unemployment claims examiners and interviewers.

Ralph D. Tive, SCSC Director, said the new examination date for these positions in the Bureau of Employment Security will be Dec. 8. Applications will be accepted until Nov. 16.

Tive pointed out that the salary range for Employment Counselors I and II has been increased. Employment Counselor I, formerly ranging from \$3925 to \$5007, has been increased to pay from \$4121 to \$5268. Employment Counselor II pays \$4551 to \$5803, an increase of more than \$200 in starting salary.

Written examinations will be scheduled at Allentown, DuBois, Erie, Harrisburg, Johnstown, Pa., Philadelphia, Pittsburgh, Scranton and Williamsport for applicants who are U. S. citizens, legal residents of Pennsylvania for at least one year prior to filing, and qualified by training and experience.

Applications and additional information concerning training and experience may be obtained from the State Civil Service Commission, Box 569, Harrisburg, Pa., offices of the Bureau of Employment Security, or the Penna. State Employment Service.
