DAIRYMEN GAIN ABOUT \$77,000

Lancaster county dairy farmers who are under the New York Federal Milk Order can expect about \$77,000 more in their milk checks during the next three months, compared to last year, according to Chester W. Smith, associate economist of Mutual Federation of Independent Cooperatives. The increase for all producers under the order will total about 7 1/2 million dollars.
Smith estimates that the producer's blended price for milk should top last year by about 40c per 100 pounds. He said that the blended price which producers receive for all milk delivered at 3 1/2% butterfat in the 200 mile zone will be \$4.55 in December, \$4.50 next January and \$4.40 in February. The December estimate is 34c over last year, while January will likely be 43c above and February 41c above.
There are 713 dairy farmers in Lancaster county who sell their milk to plants under the New York Milk Order No. 27. The three month boost in milk income will be \$108 per farm.
Condensed milk was patented by Gail Borden, a Texan.
