

DISPLAY PLANT MODEL AT STATE UNIVERSITY

A scale model of the initial two unit installation at Pennsylvania Power & Light Company's Sunbury plant has been made available to Pennsylvania State University for classroom study, according to W. S. Brokenshire, P & L's engineering vice-president.

The model, Brokenshire said, is being rotated among area colleges and universities as part of a PP&L program to help give technical students "an insight into power plant construction which might otherwise be difficult to obtain."

The model, built at a cost of \$20,000, already has been in use at Lehigh University, the Hazleton Center of Pennsylvania, State University, Lafayette College and Bucknell University. Only 148 actual plant size, it is built in three sections, each weighing about 260 pounds.
