Following a reception in Kauffman's Tea Room, Manheim R1, the couple left on a weekend trip. They will reside in Lititz.

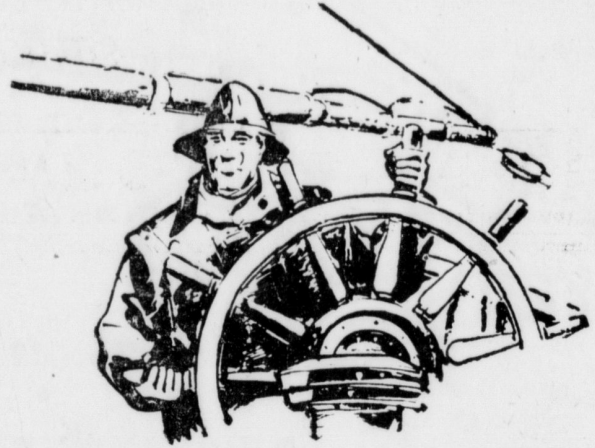

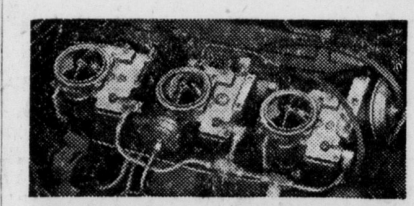
