Capt. Robert B. Heilig of the United States Navy, has been made Naval Inspector of Ordnance at the Navy guided missile factory at Pomona, Calif., operated by Convair.

A former Mount Joy boy, he is the son of Mrs. Pauline B. Heilig and the late W. R. Heilig.

A graduate of the U. S. Naval Academy in 1931, he has had many important assignments, including participation in Pacific theatre campaigns during World War II, and later as ship commander of the USS Rogers and later of the USS Adriondack, flag ship of the commander of naval forces in the Mediterranean area.

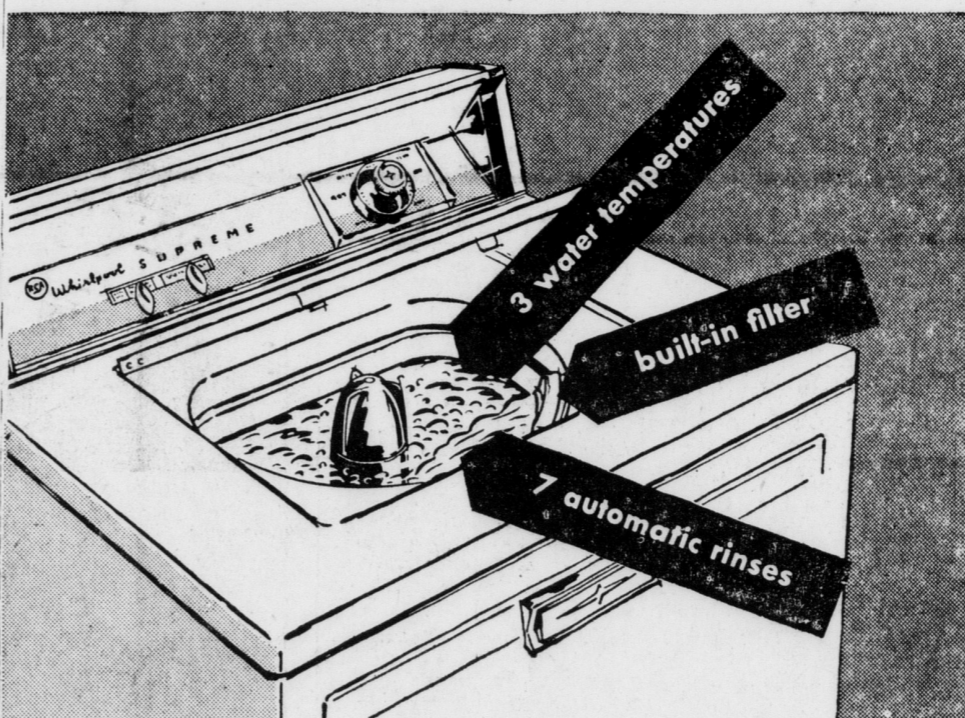
