JAPANESE MISSION WORKER TO TALK

Rev. Abe Miller, missionary to Japan under the Evangelical Alliance Mission, will speak at the Marietta Congregational Mennonite Church Sunday evening, April 14th. During the service, colored slides will be shown of his work. Miller recently returned to the States after spending five years in Japan. He and his wife, Nadyne, went to a new mission station and established a church where one never before had been organized. Out of 63 natives who have been baptized, 40 to 50 are regularly attending the weekly meetings. Mrs. Miller, while in Japan became ill with Japanese sleeping sickness. After 12 days of illness, she died on September 7, 1955. A new church building in her memory has been provided and a native worker and his wife are now in charge.
