board adopted a \$742,000 budget of proposed expenditures last Monday night for the 1957-58 school term. The estimated receipts amounted to \$742,560. This budget does not include expenditures on debt service, capital outlay or transportation, which is borne by the three individual boards separately.

The East Hempfield school district tax rate will remain at 40 mills for the next year. Both West Hempfield and Mountville borough increased their tax rates from 40 to 48 mills. Individual budgets are East Hempfield, \$657,277, receipts, \$653,144, expenses, West Hempfield, \$346,462, receipts, \$312,882, expenses, and Mountville borough, \$85,783, receipts, and \$82,290, expenses. Total estimated expenses for the three combined districts amount to \$1,048,316, and total receipts of \$1,089,522.

The three districts voted unanimously to form a union district, Peter Hohmann, solicitor, has been authorized to prepare a petition to be presented to the county commissioners. The question will be presented to the voters of the joint district in November, and should a majority of the voters from each district favor the change to the union-type district, it will become effective July, 1958.
