

Protest Delay In Gas Fumes

The Lancaster County Firemen's association will protest to state authorities the delay in determining the cause of mystery fumes in the Stauffertown water supplies. At a meeting Friday night, the group planned to contact the Public Utilities Commission requesting action in tracing the cause of gasoline-like fumes that is carried in drinking water.

County Fire Marshall Paul Z. Knier, Manheim, expressed the statement that the fumes represent a potential danger through possible explosions or fire. The county meeting was held at Bird-in-Hand.

Nominate P.M. For Maytown

President Eisenhower has sent the nomination of Henry L. Haines as postmaster of Maytown to the Senate for confirmation.

Haines, when his nomination is confirmed, will replace George Glattacker who has been acting postmaster since April, 1955, when Miss Maude Culp retired.

Haines would represent a third generation of his family to handle the post. His grandfather, the late Captain Henry A. Haines was postmaster, followed by his father, Henry B. Haines, who held the post for about 14 years, beginning in 1921.

NAMED FARMER- OF YEAR

Andrew H. Hackman, of Manheim R2, was named Lancaster County Conservation Farmer of the Year. The award was announced Thursday by Amos H. Funk, president of the Lancaster County Soil Conservation District. Mr. Hackman started out with a run-down farm 20 years ago and turned it into a thriving dairy operation through soil and water conservation measures.

When he first started, the farm produced only 10 bushels of wheat to the acre but last year, the same fields yielded 32 bushels to the acre. Manure and fertilizer and conservation explains the transformation Mr. Hackman said.
