William Snavely is program chairman, and Henry Lehman, Manheim RI, president, will preside. Plans are being made for a picnic for the members of the Landisville Lions Club and their families.

Most fellers who grow timber on their wood lots figure it's cheaper to cut it themselves than sell it to an outside operator. For one thing, you can cut wood any time you want to—such as during the slack season! Besides, most fellers are more careful if they're cutting their own trees. They'll want to get the timber out of the woods without "damaging" the younger trees, and that's mighty important. Cause good forest management depends on repeated cutting, year after year!

Here's a surprisin' fact. A fire in Northern Wisconsin in early October, 1871, killed 1,200 people—but hardly an outside operator. It knew why? Cause on that same night—October 8th—Mrs. O'Leary's cow knocked over the lantern and set fire to Chicago. And, although the Wisconsin fire killed four times as many people, it was overlooked in the excitement.

Fire can be mighty dangerous for a Tree Farm, too. I find it's well worth the time and trouble to build fire lanes through my woods, and to keep grass fires away!

Well, sir, I guess you've heard what happened to Ol' Lem. He stayed on the farm while his boy became a boot-black in town. So now he makes hay while the sun shines!
