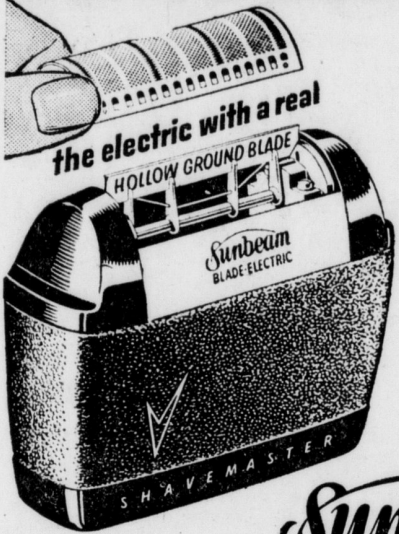

Jas. R. Zeller Becomes Major

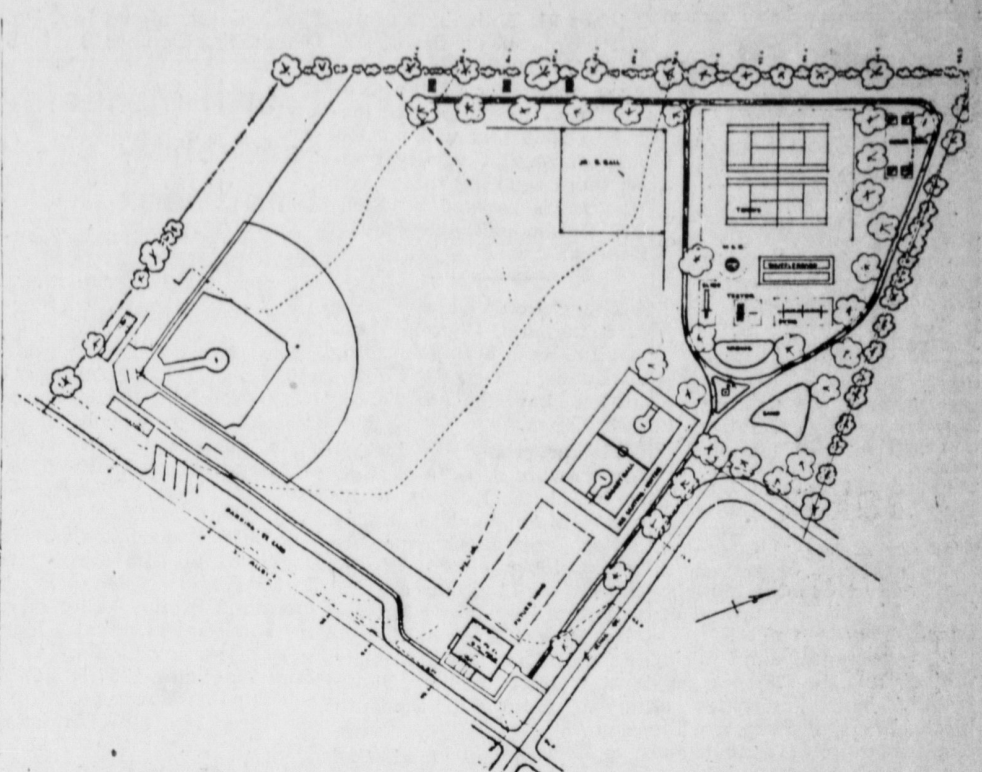

Post Office Sponsors International Letters

International Letter Writing Week will be observed in Mount Joy and community during the week October 6 to 12. Postmaster Elmer L. Zerphey has announced. Commenting on the establishment of International Letter Writing Week, Zerphey pointed out that each year since 1938 the Post Office Department has joined in the observance of National Letter Writing Week—an annual event celebrated to emphasize the meaning and value of letter writing as a symbol of American freedom. "As a result of its success," Postmaster Zerphey stated, "National Letter Writing Week will be conducted on an international basis this year for the first time. It is in charge of the special project.

The plans include a senior tee and a junior baseball diamond, basketball court, tennis courts, shuffleboard court, horseshoe pits, wading pool, swings, sliding boards and picnic pavilion. The committee is headed by Dr. Michael Gratch, post commander. First part of the project to be undertaken will be the construction of a basketball court. It will be designed so it can be flooded for ice skating in winter.

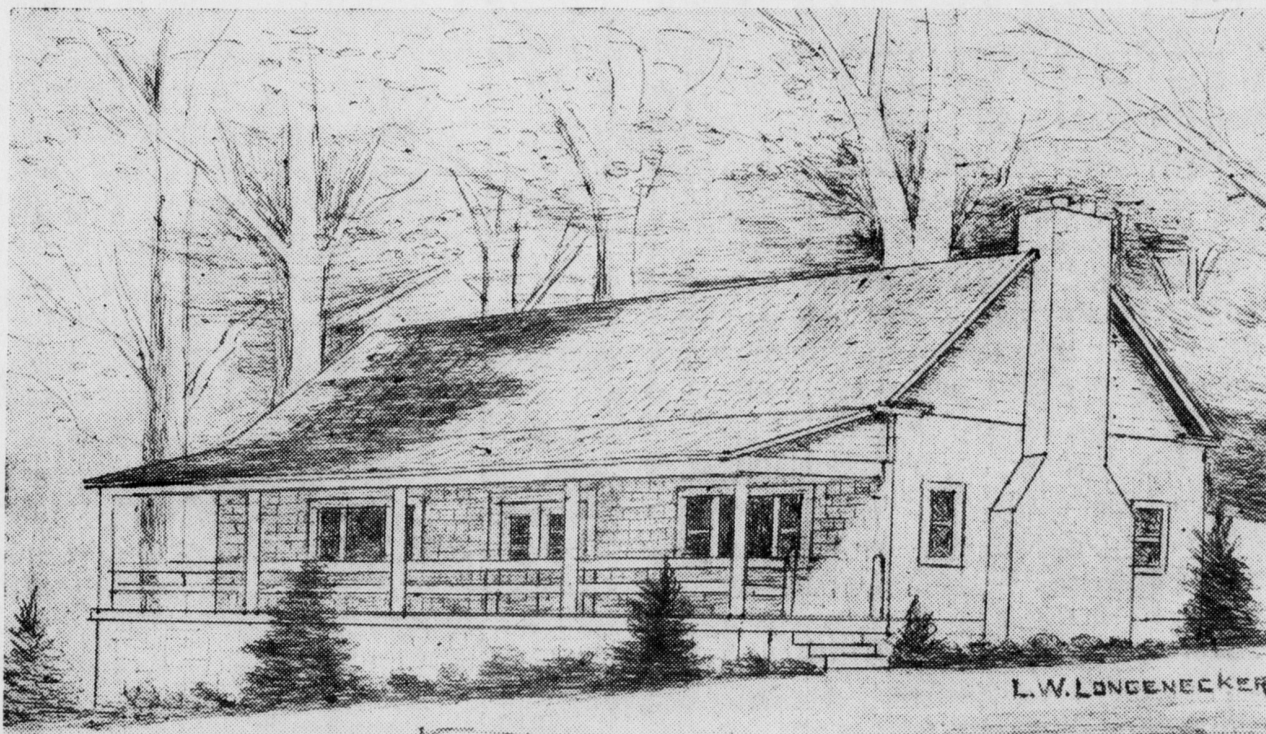
