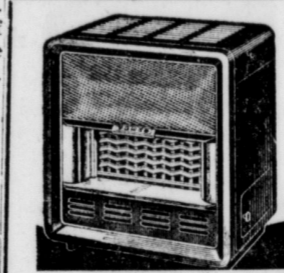
**Uninjured In Crash With Train**
