Special Advent services will be held Sunday evenings during Advent at St. Luke's Episcopal Church, Mt. Joy services beginning at 7 p. m. with Evening Prayer. Special musical numbers on the organ will be played by the organist Dr. David E. Schlosser, each evening. Motion pictures will be shown following the services during the Fellowship Hour. Pictures to be shown, First Sunday, "Saturday in Honolulu" and Haitian Primitive." Second Sunday, "Harvest in Liberia" and "Founding of Jamestown." Third Sunday, "The World Within." On the fourth Sunday evening in Advent the Christmas program by the children of the Church School will be rendered.

To Hold Hymn Sing Sunday

A Gospel Hymn Service will be presented at St. Marks E. U. B. Church of Mount Joy on Sunday evening, Dec. 1, at 7:30 o'clock. The service will be conducted by the Senior choir of St. Mark's Church and Elizabethtown Church of God. The program will be unique in that it will include a number of newer hymns as well as some of the hymns that are better known. The first offering will be "All Day Long My Heart Keeps Singing" (Dunlop), followed by "Singing I Go" (Kirkpatrick). "Precious Memories" (Cantwell) will then be rendered, after which a girls' chorus will sing, "I Fell On My Knees and Cried 'Holy'" (Cantwell). This will be followed by "Mansion Over the Hilltop" (Stanphill). Next will be a hymn on Christ's second coming, "It May Be Today" (Bixler), after which will follow a hymn which has been a favorite for many years, "Jesus, Savior, Pilot Me" (Gould). The service will conclude with two Christmas selections, "O Come, O Come, Immanuel", a thirteenth century carol, and "Christmas Time Is Come Again".

The choir, consisting of 45 voices, will be under the direction of Clifford M. Schmid of Lancaster. Miss Jane M. Hammond, also of Lancaster, is organist. The devotional part of the program will be in charge of the pastor, the Rev. C. E. Ulrich.
