Speed, dispersal, mobility and the use of atomic weapons are being stressed by the 30,000 Marines, 10,000 sailors, 60 ships and 260 aircraft taking part in the operation.

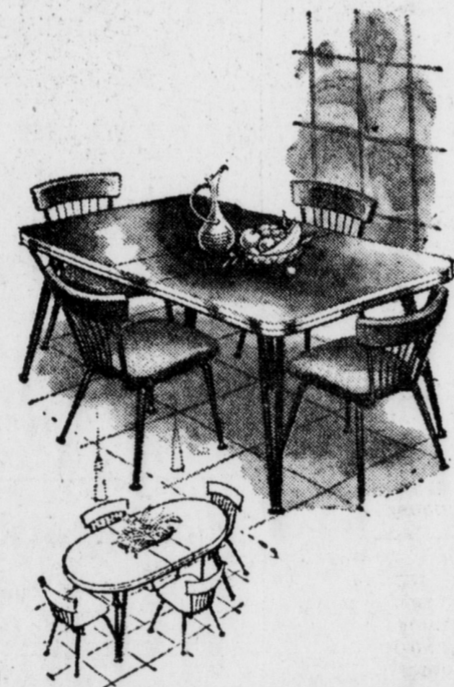

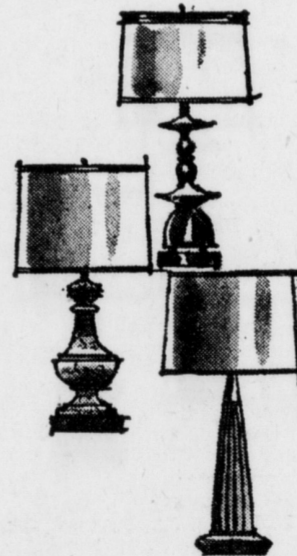
