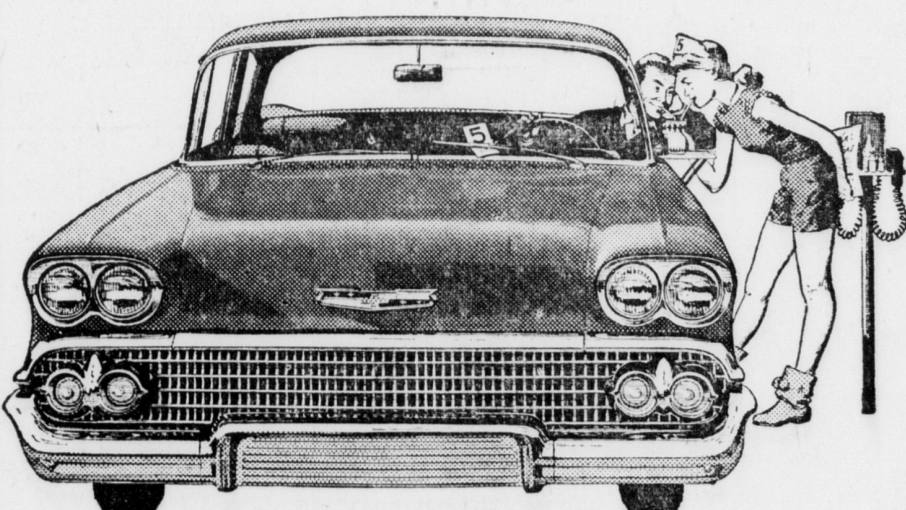
A wedding supper was held at the home of Mr. and Mrs. Isaac Huyard, New Holland R.D., sister of the bride.
