A Dakon Whirlpool Bath has been purchased for the Donegal high school through the joint efforts of the Donegal Booster Club and the Donegal high school Varsity Club. Last fall a group of citizens from the communities and area of the jointure started a fund-raising campaign to purchase the whirlpool.
