To Direct Teaching Mission

The director of the National Christian Teaching Mission, to be held in the Mount Joy and Florin area, October

23-30, will be the Reverend Kermit L. Lawton, Harrisburg, it was announced by The Reverend E. M. Moyer, general chairman of the Mission.

Sponsored by eight churches in Mount Joy and Florin, the Mission seeks to relate every resident to the pastoral care of some local congregation. The Mission launches four major projects for the purpose of projecting a year-round program of Christian outreach. During the intensive eight-day period it operates a community religious census and offers training for volunteers. Daily seminars for instruction of pastors and lay readers are also conducted by the Director.

Rev. Lawton came to his executive responsibilities with the Pennsylvania Council of Churches on Sept. 1st, 1955 from an eleven-year pastorate of the Madison Avenue Baptist Church in Albany, New York.

WATER, WATER, EVERYWHERE...

Although three-fourths of the earth's surface is covered with water, and enough water falls out of the sky to take care of our needs many times over, chemists and chemical engineers are experimenting around the clock with solar evaporators, atomic stills and electric membranes to produce fresh water from the ocean or from brackish sources.

Why all this feverish activity when already there is more than sufficient fresh water to take care of the world's needs? It's a problem of distribution—water is not available in many places where it is needed. So, the chemists are working with these complicated devices to find a method of desalting sea water at a reasonable cost.

Cost, so far, is the fly in the ointment. American cities now pay 5 to 20 cents for a thousand gallons of water. Present estimates for distilling sea water, using conventional fuels, atomic energy, or even solar energy, run from 30 cents to \$2. Chemists and chemical engineers are working every energy to come up with a method that will reduce this cost to a practical level.
