The General tells in his 'own words how God helped the Americans to meet this emergency and gave their leader strength and wisdom to lead his

men to victory "There I was on the night of September 5-my plans twisted, yet know ing we must sail the next morning.

"Did the Germans know about the invasion? How much did they know? Just what would we run into?

"All these things were running through my mind, and with the fate of so many thousands of men, as well as the hopes of the free world, resting upon the success of the invasion, I was literally overwhelmed with a sense of

my responsibility. "Troubled and worried, I went to my cabin. A sense of my own helplessness swept over me. I desperately needed help from some greater power.


