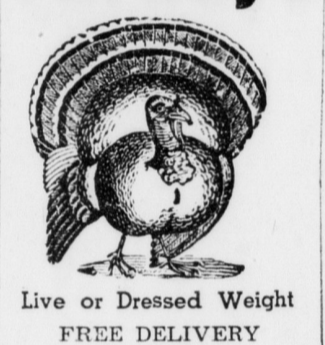

EARNINGS DOWN FROM YEAR AGO

Earnings accruing to the common stock of Pennsylvania Power & Light Company for the twelve months ended October 31 were \$18,682,369, equivalent to \$3.16 per share of common stock outstanding at such date.

This compares with \$19,380,756 or \$3.28 per share for the twelve months ended October 31, 1957. Revenues for the twelve months ended October 31, 1958 were \$130,253,577 as compared with revenues of \$129,867,337 for the previous year.

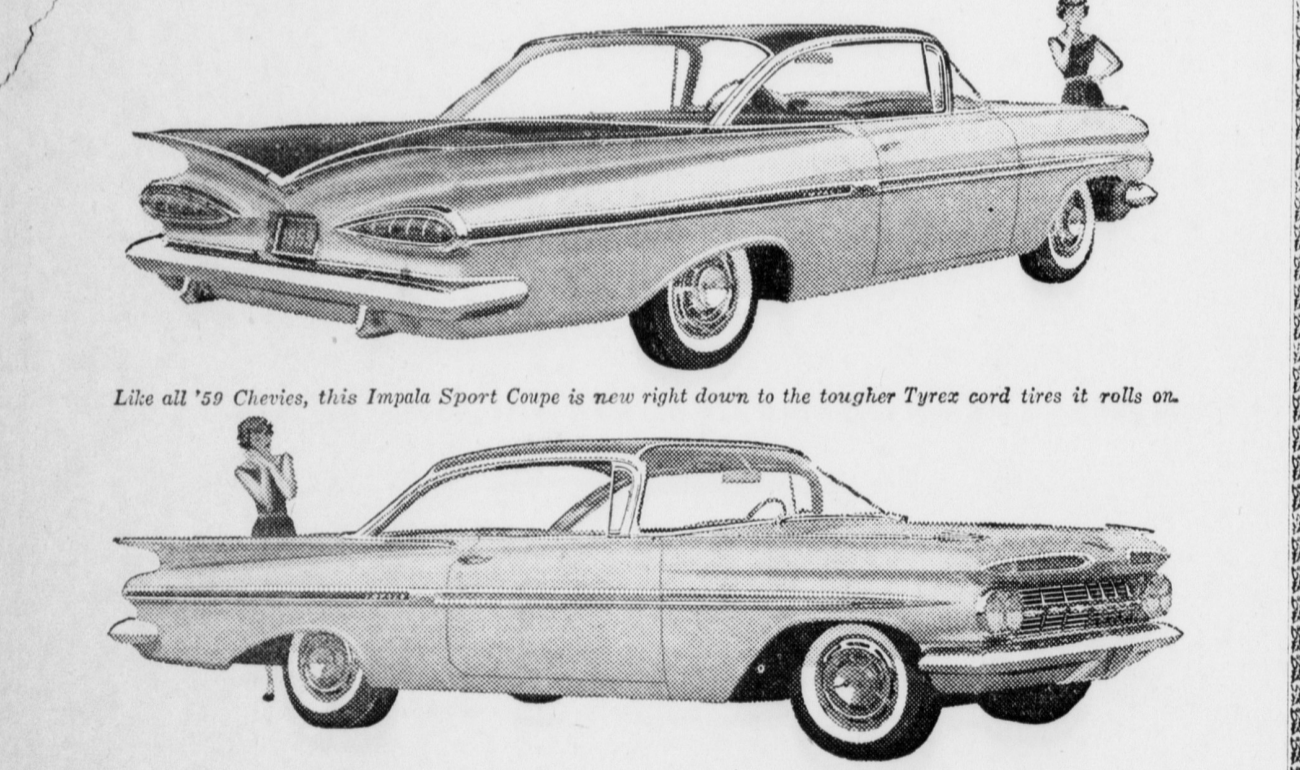
