2 - Proof of age?  
Ans. - A birth certificate is not required. There are at least 20 other documents acceptable in lieu of a birth certificate.  
3 - When to apply?  
Ans. - Application should be made at least a month before retirement date to assure prompt payment. At the time of application a list of documents which are acceptable as proof of age may be obtained.  
4 - Can I continue to work and still be eligible for benefit?  
Ans. - Yes, provided you are under age 65. Disability benefits to anyone attaining age 50.
