AN ORDINANCE
ESTABLISHING CERTAIN STREETS AS ONE WAY STREETS
IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Mount Joy, Lancaster County, Pa., as follows:
SECTION 1. The following streets or parts of streets in the Borough of Mount Joy, are hereby designated as one-way streets, and vehicular traffic thereon shall move in the direction hereinafter stated, name by:
(a) Walnut Street from Marietta Avenue to Sassafras Alley shall be a one-way street southbound only.
(b) Sassafras Alley from Walnut Street to South Barbara Street eastbound only.
SECTION 2. It shall be unlawful to drive or operate any vehicle on the said one-way streets in a direction other than the direction hereinabove provided. Any person who shall violate this ordinance shall upon conviction thereof, in a summary proceeding, pay a fine of not less than \$2.00 nor more than \$10.00 and costs of prosecution, and in default of payment thereof, shall undergo imprisonment not exceeding five days.
