The Sins of Guide For Our Citizens Absentee Voters

Ten "sins against citizenship" are too often committed by Americans. The following is a condensed guide of the Commonwealth to clarify the regulations on Civilian absentee voting: Who May Request Absentee Ballot?

Any qualified elector of Pennsylvania who is PROPERLY REGISTERED - AND ENROLLED and who:

- (1) On the occurrence of any election IS UNAVOIDABLY absent from the county of his voting residence by reason of his DUTIES, BUSINESS OR OCCUPATION, or
- (2) Is unable to attend at his proper polling place by reason of ILLNESS or PHYSICAL DISABILITY, may request an Absentee Ballot.

How To Apply For Absentee Ballot

1. Electors who are in the county of residence during the thirty (30) day period prior to an election but who expect to be unavoidably absent on the day of election must apply IN PERSON to the chief clerk of the county board of elections and THEN and THERE complete the official application.

(NOTE: No application received earlier than thirty (30) days before an election or later than seven (7) days before election is valid.)

2. Electors who expect to be unavoidably absent during the thirty (30) days preceding an election may signify their desire to the chief clerk of the county board of elections in writing which they have personally signed.

(NOTE: The chief clerk will mail the proper forms to such electors and the application may be completed and sent to the chief clerk not to be delivered earlier than the thirtieth (30th) day and no later than the seventh (7th) day preceding the day of the election, otherwise the application is void.)

3. Electors who expect to be unable to attend their proper polling places on the day of an election because of ILLNESS or PHYSICAL DISABILITY may so advise the chief clerk of the county board of elections in writing personally signed by them.

Receipt and Mailing of Absentee Ballot

The chief clerk of the county board of elections upon finding the application complete and determining that the applicant is qualified to vote, will hand or mail an official absentee ballot to the applicant.

The elector should follow the instructions contained with the Absentee Ballot.

The completed ballot must be mailed in sufficient time so that the DAY OF THE ELECTION IS WHICH THE BALLOT IS TO BE CAST.
