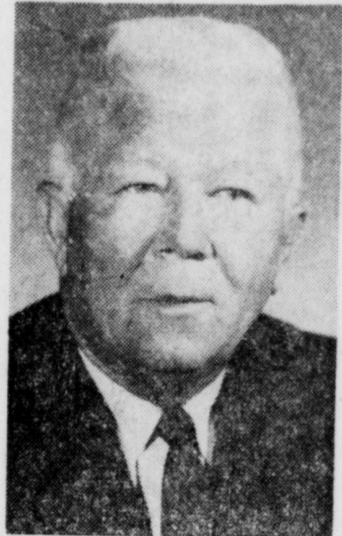
Senior English Class Wins Honor In Project Contest
