AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING ADDITIONAL STOP INTERSECTIONS IN THE BOROUGH OF MOUNT JOY.

IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Mount Joy, Lancaster County, Penna. as follows:

An Ordinance adopted April 6, 1953 and entitled "An Ordinance establishing certain stop intersections in the Borough of Mount Joy and authorizing the erection of signs so indicating, and imposing penalties" is hereby amended by adding to the said Ordinance immediately after Section 1.2, a new subsection to be designed as Section 1.3 as follows:

Section 1.3: The following additional intersections are hereby designated as Stop Intersections, and signs of the type approved by the Secretary of Highways of Pennsylvania shall be erected on the street at the intersections indicated below, to wit:

(a) the east side of New Haven Street, and

(b) the west side of New Haven Street.

On Delta Street where it intersects the south side of Columbia Avenue
