**Fruit Diseases Are Studied By State Scientists**  
Vigorous attempts to identify viruses causing diseases of tree fruits are on the program of scientists with the Agricultural Experiment Station at the Pennsylvania State University. John S. Boyle, University Park, and Fred H. Lewis, Fruit Research Laboratory, are associated in these efforts. While this research is basic in nature, it is aimed at the discovery of virus diseases of cherries, plums, peaches, and pears. **Warn Kids About Kite Flying**  
"Benjamin Franklin made electrical history by flying a kite in a thunderstorm. By all odds, he should have had a fatal accident. Flying kites near electric lines can be equally dangerous," warned G. T. Storb, PP&L Lancaster division vice-president. The local utility representative expressed concern for youngsters who are now taking advantage of windy days to send their kites aloft. He said, "A young girl or boy intent on seeing a kite just a little higher may not see the overhead wires that could end their kite flying. To avoid this danger, he outlined seven safety rules that will 'keep kite flying fun.' They were:

1. Always fly your kite in an open field.
2. Never run across the road while flying a kite.
3. Keep kites away from power lines and TV antennas.
4. Never fly a kite in the rain or fly a kite with wet string.
5. Never fly a kite with metal string or wires or any wire that has metal in it.
6. Never use metal on kite poles.
7. If your kite gets caught on electric wires or a pole, let it alone. Better to lose a kite than your life.

Henning, State Secretary of Agriculture, said were about 35 percent of the total Livestock losses, including lightning damage not always resulting in fire, averaged 14.2 cents per \$100 of insurance in force at the end of the year. This compares with the rate of 14.8 cents for 1959.

Personal property losses were about 15 percent of all claims and accounting for more dollars than any other livestock property item. Most livestock claims were due to lightning.
