Rotary Hears Of Tokyo Trip

Joseph Kettering of Elizabethtown, who was an official delegate to the recent Rotary International convention in Tokyo, was the speaker Tuesday noon at the weekly luncheon meeting of the Mount Joy Rotary club, held at Hostetters.

Giving some of his impressions both of the convention and of his trip to some 14 countries on his trip to and from Japan, he used various incidents to point out some of the differences and some of the similarities of the U.S. and foreign nations.

Kettering, a certified public accountant in Harrisburg was an official delegate to the convention, representing the Elizabethtown Rotary club.

As early as 1859, 24 newspapers covered the U. S. Senate for 21 newspapers and the Associated Press while 51 reporters covered the House of Representatives for the papers.
