## ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING ADDITIONAL STOP INTERSECTIONS WITHIN THE BOROUGH OF MOUNT JOY.

IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Mount Joy, Lancaster County, Pennsylvania, as follows:  
An ordinance adopted April 6, 1953 and entitled "An Ordinance establishing certain stop intersections in the Borough of Mount Joy and authorizing the erection of signs so indicating, and imposing penalties," is hereby amended by adding to the said Ordinance immediately after Section 1.4, a new subsection to be designated as Section 1.5 as follows:  
Section 1.5: The following additional intersections are hereby designated as Stop Intersections, and signs of the type approved by the Secretary of Highways of Pennsylvania shall be erected on the street at the intersection indicated below, to wit:  
On Richland Lane where it intersects the west side of Pinkerton Road.

## Guest Leader

Dan West, founder of Heifer Project Inc., and for 20 years Peace Education Director for his Church, will be the guest leader in a Peace Institute to be held in the Elizabethtown Church of the Brethren, November 12-13. He will meet with various groups of the church and speak in a public meeting each evening at 7:30.

While a relief worker in Spain in the later 1930's, Dan West longed for a more lasting solution to feeding hungry children than handing out food. Gazing at the grassy hillside, he wondered why bread cattle could not be shipped to provide needy families with ever increasing amounts of milk.

As World War II neared an end, Dan West, with the backing of his denomination, the Church of the Brethren, put his idea into action. Before long it expanded into an independent, interdenominational endeavor known as Heifer Project, Inc. To date the agency has distributed more than 11,000 heifers in 39 countries, each on the condition that the firstborn heifer was to be passed on to another needy family.
