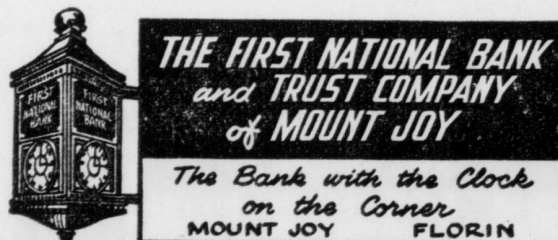

State Departments. The other Department of Public Welfare. This Office was headquarters for 41 State institutions and centers. It controlled and maintained 715 mobile buildings; Finance or Building; a three-level parking facility; Health and Welfare Building; and Labor and Industry Building. Myers also will maintain field offices in the Philadelphia and the Pittsburgh State Office Buildings.

Three years later he transferred to the Department of Property and Supplies as the Chief of Building Operations in the Bureau of Grounds and Buildings. Prior to State service, the farmer's problems were the active concern of the Storage Division in the city, and the city dweller can gain the interest of the farmer, a greater understanding of cooperative storage area, received and action develops.
