Give Reminder To Taxpayers

A reminder to residents of the Mount Joy area is issued this week by the Lancaster County Personal Property Tax Bureau concerning filing of tax forms.

Everyone living in the county who owns certain intangibles such as mortgages, notes, certain stocks and bonds equitable interest is required to file a personal property tax return.

The tax is levied at the rate of four mills on each dollar of value of the taxable personal property.

Deadline date for filing is Feb. 15. Reporting forms are available from all Lancaster county banks and assistance, the bureau says, to fill out the returns is available from accountants, attorneys, banks or Personal Property Tax Bureau.
