

### Builder To Hold Open House

Hempfield Associates, Inc., this week announced that it will have the first public viewing of its new West View subdivision, located on Donegal Springs road between Chocolate and Florin avenues, on Saturday and Sunday, September 29 and 30.

West View is planned as a 75-home development of 3-bedroom homes in the \$12,500 class. American Ranch, Colonial and Cape Cod designs with 10 different elevations will be offered.

The homes are manufactured by Inland Homes Corporation, Piqua, Ohio. The first home erected is the company's Buccaneer model.

"We are convinced that the Buccaneer offers more living space with added conveniences and special construction features than other lower priced home, D. N. Black, secretary of Hempfield Associates, said. Inland Homes received national recognition last year in home and business publications for its concentration on well-designed low-cost housing during a period of rising homebuilding costs, Black said. All of the homes are architect designed and meet FHA standards, he added.

### P.P.&L. Plans Expansion Move

Addition of a second generating unit at Pennsylvania Power & Light Co's Brunner Island power plant moves closer to reality with the awarding of three major contracts, it has been announced by W. S. Brokenshire, the utility's engineering and construction vice president.

The utility has contracted with Stone & Webster for the engineering design, with Westinghouse Electric Corporation for a 350,000 kilowatt cross-compound turbine generator having an expected capability of 390,000 kilowatts, and with Combustion Engineering Corporation for the plant's huge boiler. Other necessary contracts, will be awarded with the firming-up of the plant's detailed design and the development of actual construction schedules.

The present timetable calls for the start of construction in early 1963 and completion of the plant in the fall of '65. Completion of the new unit will increase the total station capability to over 700,000 kilowatts, making it the largest single power plant on the PP&L system. The initial generating unit which went into service in June, 1961, now has a capability of 320,000 kilowatts.

Brokenshire said construction of the second unit will be at a much faster rate than for the first because a large part of the initial preparation and construction was completed with requirements for the additional units in mind. The present water intake structure, chimney, roads, dikes as well as most rail, transmission, car dumper and coal-handling facilities will serve both the first and second units.

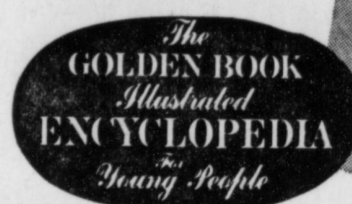
